## CHURCHYARD SURVEY

Over the last few months a small team, a subset of the PCC, has conducted a full audit of the churchyard to assess the extent of violations of official regulations (see the Diocese website for copies of this). This has become necessary due to changes in Health and Safety legislation (which seriously impact our churchyard helpers) and a number of complaints. The group will present its recommendations to the PCC in September, following which, relatives will be asked formally by letter to make the necessary alterations to bring the grave space into line with regulations. We appreciate the sensitivity of this action, but remember it's also difficult for those that have to balance the safety of our volunteers and very sensible Churchyard regulations with those of relatives. If you have any concerns please speak to the Churchwardens or Rector.
