Retrak is one of the charities we support and is the one we have adopted for August 2018. Retrak's vision is of a world where no child has to live on the street; it aims to find a sustainable path away from the streets to a family-based home where children can flourish, grow safely and fulfil their dreams.

Last year Emma Hodge wrote about the charity: 'Retrak does not only look after the street children, a vital element of their work is also prevention, looking at the underlying reasons why many children feel they have to live on the street. Retrak works in areas where children are particularly vulnerable and works to strengthen families both economically and socially through self help groups.'

This year, Retrak became part of Hope for Justice, a global organisation that aims to end human trafficking and modern-day slavery, and acquired a new CEO, Ben Cooley, in the process.
