# SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS FOR THE CHURCHYARD OF ST MICHAEL AND ALL ANGELS, SANDHURST

The Chancellor of the Diocese makes the following regulations which supplement the Churchyard Regulations for the Diocese Oxford

### Application, commencement and interpretation

- 1. These Regulations apply only to the churchyard of St Michael and All Angels, Sandhurst.
- **2.** They come into operation on the day on which they are made and remain in operation until further order of the Chancellor.
- **3.** In these Regulations–

"the Diocesan Regulations" means the Diocese of Oxford Churchyard Regulations 2016; and

"existing" means existing on the date on which these Regulations come into operation.

#### Extended delegation of authority to incumbent

- **4.** Despite anything to the contrary in the Diocesan Regulations, the Rector of Sandhurst has delegated authority to authorise
  - (a) the introduction of monuments and ledger stones with inscriptions in gold, silver or white lettering; and
  - (b) the addition of an inscription in gold, silver or white lettering to an existing monument or ledger stone;

provided that the inscription in every other respect meets the requirements of the Diocesan Regulations.

## **Supplementary**

**5.** If any question arises as to the interpretation or application of these Regulations, it is to be referred to the Chancellor for determination.
