1	Who was on the throne in Britain in 1865?	<b>Queen Victoria</b>
2	Which Prime Minister came to office following the death of his predecessor?	<b>Lord John Russell</b>
3	Which British monarch was born in 1865?	<b>Prince George of Wales (later George V;)</b>
4	The first speed limit was introduced in 1865 but what was the speed limit in towns?	<b>2 mph</b>
5	Which political party was in power in GB?	<b>Liberal / Whig (either accepted)</b>
6	Which tube station was opened in 1865?	<b>Barbican (originally Aldersgate) and Epping (either answer accepted)</b> (North Weald is no longer a tube station but you got ½ a point for it) (Moorgate was not originally a tube station)
7	Which army was started and what was it originally called?	<b>Salvation Army, originally called "East London Christian Mission"</b>
8	Which nurse, who was executed in WW1, was born in 1865?	<b>Edith Cavell</b>
9	Who was the last person publically hanged in Glasgow (on Glasgow Green) and what crime had they committed?	<b>Edward William Pritchard for poisoning his wife and mother-in-law in the city.</b>
10	Who was the British Prime Minister who died?	<b>Henry John Temple / Vicount Palmerston</b>
11	A competition was held to design which London railway station and who won it?	<b>St Pancras won by George Gilbert Scott</b>
12	The only outbreak in Britain, of which disease occurred and in which city?	<b>Yellow Fever in Swansea</b> Cholera & Cattle Plague (or Rinderpest) had several outbreaks in other years – note the word <i>only</i> in the question.
13	Who graduates as Britain's first woman doctor?	<b>Elizabeth Garrett Anderson</b>
14	What is transferred to London Zoo and becomes a popular attraction?	<b>Jumbo (an African Elephant)</b>
15	Where was there an unsuccessful uprising against British rule?	<b>Morant Bay, Jamaica</b>
16	What did Joseph Lister discover in 1865?	<b>Sterilising effects of Carbolic Acid (Antiseptic for ½ point)</b>
17	Which Dickens Novel was published in 1865?	<b>Our Mutual Friend</b>
18	Which best-selling children's book was first published?	<b>Alice's Adventures in Wonderland</b>
19	Which famous author died in 1865?	<b>Mrs Isabella Beeton / Elizabeth Gaskell (either accepted)</b>
20	Which Nobel prize winning author was born in 1865?	<b>Rudyard Kipling / William Butler Yeats (either accepted)</b>
21	Which Irish poet was born?	<b>William Butler Yeats / Alice Milligan (either accepted)</b>
22	Which war ended?	<b>American Civil War / Duar War with Bhutan (either accepted)</b>
23	Which president was assassinated?	<b>Abraham Lincoln</b>
24	Which US government agency was founded?	<b>US Secret Service</b>
25	Which amendment to the US constitution was ratified and adopted?	<b>13th Amendment which abolishes slavery</b>
26	Which American University was founded?	<b>Cornell University</b>
27	The Battle of Powder River occurred, but which group of Native Americans fought the battle?	<b>Cheyenne</b>
28	Which country regains independence from Spain?	<b>Dominican Republic</b>
29	The summit of which mountain was first reached?	<b>Matterhorn</b>
30	Which European country moved its capital? The capital would subsequently move again.	<b>Italy (Turin to Florence)</b>

31	Which European King came to the throne?	<b>Leopold II of Belgium</b>
32	In 1865, a country moves its capital to its current city. Name the country and the city it moved from and the city it moved to.	<b>New Zealand, Auckland to Wellington / Canada; Quebec to Ottawa</b> (either accepted)
33	Which kingdom was declared in 1865?	<b>Kingdom of Redonda</b>
34	Taskent was conquered; but by which country?	<b>Russia</b> (Taskent is now the capital of Uzbekistan)
35	Which Wagner opera was premiered in March 1865?	<b>Tristan and Isolde</b>
36	Which French composer was born?	<b>Paul Dukas</b>
37	Which musical show had its first London performance in 1865?	<b>Orpheus in the Underworld by Jacques Offenbach</b>
38	Which Finnish composer was born?	<b>Jean Sibelius</b>
39	Which symphony debuts in Vienna 43 years after its composition? (Composer & Title)	<b>Franz Schubert's Unfinished Symphony</b>
40	Who wrote the "Horn Trio in E-Flat Major" in 1865?	<b>Johannes Brahms</b>
41	Which symphony was written in 1865 but then lost until 1923 and not performed until 1936?	<b>Symphony No 1 (The Bells of Zlonice) by Antonin Dvorak</b>
42	What parts of the current church were built after 1865?	<b>North Porch &amp; Choir Vestry</b>
43	When was the re-dedication ceremony held? (Date and month, not just the year!)	<b>23<sup>rd</sup> December 1865</b>
44	Who was the Rector of St. Michael's in 1865?	<b>Henry Parsons</b>
45	Which Diocese did St. Michael's belong in 1865?	<b>Oxford</b>
46	Who was the architect of St. Michael's?	<b>J. Woodman designed the extensions with approval from G.E. Street the original architect</b> (either answer accepted)
47	What are the words that are carved into the pulpit?	<b>We preach Christ (God) crucified, the power of God &amp; the Wisdom of God</b>
48	Which aisle was added to the church in 1865?	<b>North Aisle</b>
49	What part of the church was rebuilt in 1865?	<b>Chancel (and space for the organ)</b>
50	Who was the archbishop of Canterbury in 1865?	<b>Charles Thomas Longley</b>
51	Which hymn was written by Sabine Baring-Gould in 1865?	<b>Onward Christian Soldiers</b>
52	Which act makes it clear that the bishop may not impose any declaration or oath on a member of the clergy other than those imposed by law or canon?	<b>Clerical Subscription Act.</b>
53	Isaac Williams died in 1865. Which hymn did he write?	<b>Be thou my guardian and Guide / Lord in Thy Mercy's Day</b> (Either accepted)
54	What Christmas Carol was published in 1865?	<b>We Three Kings / What Child is This?</b>
55	Which book in the bible has 150 chapters?	<b>Psalms</b>
56	What according to the bible lasted for 150 days?	<b>Genesis 7:24 – Flood – water on earth</b>
57	In 1 Kings 10, 150 silver shekels was the price for what?	<b>importing horses from Egypt (v29)</b>
58	Which animal is mentioned 150 times in the bible?	<b>Horses, Donkeys, Lions</b> (as it depends on which version of the bible you use, any of the above were accepted)
59	In the bible, approximately 150 gallons of water was used, but what happened to it?	<b>Turned into wine</b>
60	Which of the patriarchs lived in 1865 BC?	<b>Abraham / Jacob</b> (depending on which resource was used to find the answer out)
