Our charity for August

In the late 1970's, the Day Centre was established in a temporary building donated by the Yateley Round Table. This was opened for the active elderly over 55's. In 1981 a committee was established to raise funds for a permanent brick building. After years of fund raising events, donations and Grants, the dream was realised.

The present Day Centre opened in 1989 where the present membership is 57 with ages now ranging 70-100. Members can attend daily between

9am-4pm where there are fully qualified carers and volunteers to assist with all needs, including serving a two-course lunch, coffee and tea Monday to Friday.

Transport is available between Crowthorne and Sandhurst.

The Day Centre is a non-profit charitable organisation that seeks to provide a stimulating environment offering service of chiropody, hairdressing, church service and varied entertainment.

There is a daily Carers Drop-in-service available for a fee charged by the hour for those carers in the community who feel they could benefit from this service.
